Zanjan: Mahneshan, Alam-Kandy, Ghar-Ghalan, 2500-2800 m, 27 June 1983, Moussavi, Habibi & Tehrani 40494 - E.

This species is reported as a new record to the flora of Iran. It was recorded in Flora Iranica (cf. Rechinger 1968 p. 143) from a single and in fact type locality in Iraqi Kordestan. The new gathering is second collection of the species and it is at a distance of about

400 km to the east of first collection. Fibigia thesigeri is a low turfy somewhat woody plant with covering of the greyish appressed stellate hairs. Flowering branches 5-9 cm high, bearing yellow flowers. Silicule suborbicular.
