This species with the linear or linear-lanceolate leaves and the elliptical-lanceolate herbaceous bracteoles with 3-7 nerves, which are exceeding the flowers is distinguished from the other annual species.

The closest locality to the Iranian gathering is in Iraq Kordestan (Rechinger 1987, p. 276).

The geographical distribution of the species is Anatolia, Syria, and Palestina?.
